Our Vision

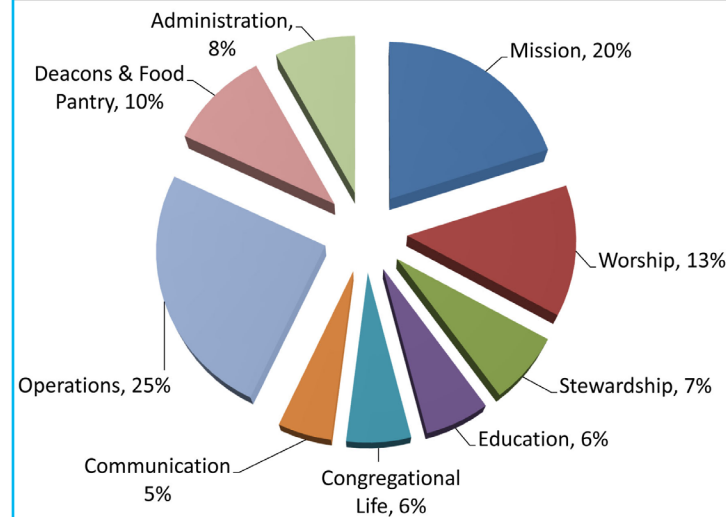
