3. Photograph/draw any of the above, in a Biblical setting. For example, how big is a mustard seed? How might you illustrate, in a photograph or a drawing, the Parable of the Mustard seed? This story appears in Matthew 13:31-32, Mark 4: 30-32 and Luke 13: 18-19.
 4. Create a photograph/video to illustrate a line of scripture. For example, Matthew 19:24 says, "Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." You could use children's toys to illustrate this-a camel and a needle (with thanks to Liam McAuliffe who I think suggested this)
 5. Make a video-you could make a video of planting a mustard seed.
